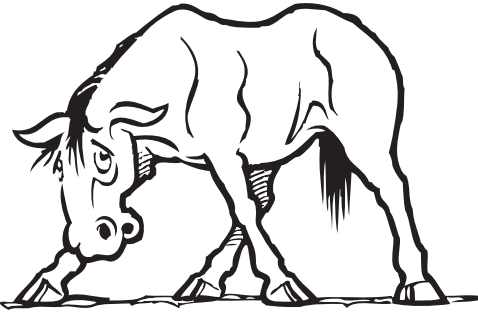


# Natural Knowledge for Horse Owners

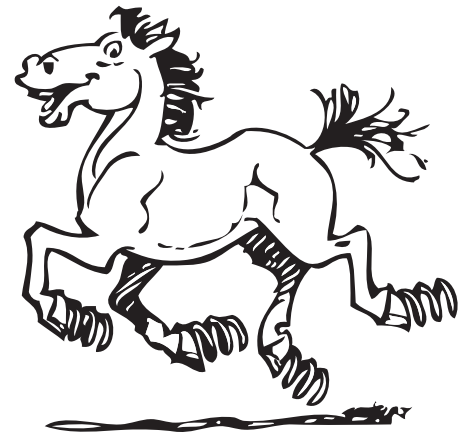
